KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That... I, Daisy Todd Wilson

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said... R. E. Ingold, his heirs and assigns, forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in Austin Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on waters of Giler's Creek, waters of Enoree River, containing 148 acres, more or less, being composed of a 65 acre tract and an 83 acre tract, as shown by a plat of the J. Thomas Austin estate made by J. N. Southern in October 1890, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stone the northwest corner, thence N 76-3/4 E 16.50 to a stone; thence N 75 E 9.13 to a stone; thence N 6 W 26.80 to Giler's Creek and hickory; thence down said creek to a stone; thence S 35 W 10.35 to a stone; thence S 18 E 12.25 to a stone; thence S 23-3/4 E 22.70 to a stone; thence S 65 1/4 W 39.99 to a stone; thence N 40 1/2 W 8.45 to a stone; thence N 15 1/2 W 23.00 to the beginning corner, bounded on the north by Giler's Creek and other lands now or formerly belonging to F. C. and J. A. Todd, on the east by lands now or formerly of G. B. Yeargin, on the South by lands now or formerly of F. M. Todd, and on the west by lands now or formerly of T. M. Vaughn.

ALSO all that other piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, Austin Township, on waters of Giler's Creek, waters of Enoree River, containing 81-7/8 acres, more or less, being composed of a tract of 39.52 acres and a tract of 42.35 acres, as shown by a survey made by T. P. Epton in November 1917, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stone the southwest corner of the F. C. Todd tract, thence N 6-3/4 W 10.56 to Giler's Creek; thence down the meanders of said creek to a black gum, thence S 4-3/4 E 17.10 to a stone; thence S 10-3/4 E 9.50 to a stone; thence S 75 1/4 W 54.00 to a stone; the beginning corner, bounded on the north by Giler's Creek, on the east by lands now or formerly of F. C. Todd, on the south by lands now or formerly of F. C. Todd and T. M. Vaughn and on the west by lands now or formerly of W. T. Austin.

This is the same property conveyed to the Grantor by deed of Hugh G. Wilson, dated December 9, 1942, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S.C., in Deed Book 250 at page 206.

Grantor to pay 1951 taxes.

The Grantor is to have possession of this property until January 1, 1952 with the right to gather all crops now growing on the premises above described.
