POWER OF ATTORNEY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That I, James F. Clark, a legal resident of Greenville, South Carolina, now in the military service of the Army of the United States and temporarily residing without the territorial limits of the United States, have made and appointed and do hereby make and appoint my father, A. H. Clark of Greenville, South Carolina, my true and lawful attorney to:

(a) For me and in my name to ask, demand, sue for, collect, receive and give satisfaction for all sums of money, debts and demands whatsoever which are or shall be due, owing, or belonging to me from any person or persons whatsoever.

(b) For me and in my name to demand, sue for and receive all rents and arrears of rents now due or which shall any time hereafter become due to me from any tenants or occupants from any and all real estate belonging to me, and on payment thereof to give receipts and discharges for the same and on non-payment of the same to institute and prosecute any and all actions for the recovery of such rent and for the ejectment of any tenants or occupants who may be in default and for the recovery of the possession of the real estate.

(c) And generally to perform all and every act, matter and thing whatsoever in and about my estate, property and affairs, as fully as I might or could do in my own proper person; the above specifically enacted powers being in aid of the full, complete and general powers herein granted and not in limitation thereof; and I hereby ratify all my said attorney shall lawfully do or
