presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Pauline H. Curzon and Thomas  
L. Curzon, their heirs and execs forever,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Click Springs, Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, lying and being "out out on" the north east  
of the City of Greer, S. C., on the east side of an iron street  
which intersects the Greer-Clemel Highway, the said street running  
east west as lot #2 on Plat No. 1 of the property of "L. J.  
Jones Estate", plat made by W. S. Precision, surveyor, on Aug. 24,  
1951, and recorded in Plat book 100, at Page 301, R. I. O. Office for  
Greenville County, and viz., according to said Plat, the following  
corner and dist. per, to wit:
