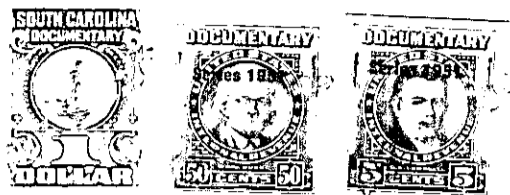

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Emory Alexander

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One hundred fifty and no/100  
(150.00) Dollars

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents  
by Paul H. Reese

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these  
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Paul H. Reese and his heirs and  
assigns forever:

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, situate, lying and being on the North Side of  
Crain Drive, near Fairview Baptist Church and about 2-1/2 mile northwest  
of Greer, the same being known and designated as lots 26, 27, and 28  
on a plat of the property of John B. and Lencie L. Crain Estate made  
by H.S. Brockman, surveyor, dated May 12, 1948, and recorded in Vol.  
\_\_\_\_, Pg.\_\_\_\_, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:-

BEGINNING at a stake on the North edge of Crain Drive, Joint corner of  
25 and 26, and running thence along the Northern edge of said Crain  
Drive S 61-00 E 150 feet to a stake, joint corner of lots 28 and 29,  
thence as the dividing line between lots 28 and 29, N 29-00 E 273.1 feet  
to a stake on the Perry Smith line, thence N 65-07 W 150.51 feet to a stake  
thence as the dividing line between lots 25 and 26, S 29-00 W  
261.3 feet to the beginning corner.
