of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, and upon receipt of \$1325.00,
HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release
unto the said E. L. Craigo

"All that tract of land on the Hunts Bridge Road in School Dist.
10-B, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing 7½ acres,
more or less, and having the following description:

BEGINNING on a stone on the Hunt's Bridge Road and running
thence S. 66 W. 7.71 to a stone xom; thence N. 37½ W. 7.80 to a stone
om; thence N. 64-2/3 E. 11.25 to a stake in Hunt's Bridge Road; thence
with said road S. 10½ E. 8 chs. to the beginning corner, and containing
7½ acres, more or less.

This being a portion of the property conveyed to J. O. Mathis
(Mathews) by deed of Julia D. Charles dated February 16, 1926, and record-
