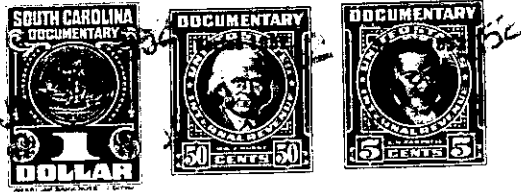

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS. That We, A. L. Yelton, Gertrude Peterson  
and Undeain P. Yelton  
in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred Sixty Six (\$366.00)  
Dollars  
to US  
in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents  
by John Peterson and Lynell Peterson  
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these  
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said John Peterson and Lynell Peterson

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Glassy Mountain Township,  
County, State of South Carolina, on branch waters of Tyger River, containing  
120 acres, more or less, and being the same land conveyed to Ora Turner  
by her husband, Elis Turner, by his deed dated October 15, 1924. The  
same land was conveyed to the said Elis Turner by B. F. Neves, J. H.  
Roe and T. P. Neves by their deed dated December 26, 1923 and recorded  
in the office of the R. M. C., Greenville County in Book 83, Page 115.  
It is also the same tract of land as was conveyed to the said B. F.  
Neves, J. H. Roe, and T. P. Neves doing business as B. F.  
Neves and Company, by Emanuel Pruitt by his deed dated August 5, 1891, and  
recorded in the office of the R. M. C., Greenville County in Book XX, at  
page 814. It is likewise the same tract of land as was conveyed to the  
said Emanuel Pruitt on the 16th day of June, 1884 by Perry B. Moore, deed  
recorded in the office of the R. M. C., Greenville County in Book LL, Page  
115. The deed to Ora Turner/<sup>of the said tract of land</sup>is recorded in Book 96, Page 183. The de-  
scription as carried in the deeds herein referred to is adopted and made  
a part hereof. And it is specifically understood and agreed that this  
deed is to cover, include and convey all the land covered by the said deeds  
This is the same tract of land conveyed to T. H. Peterson and C. N.  
Garland by Ora Turner by deed dated June 4, 1941, recorded in Deed Book  
236, Page 65. By successive conveyances the interest acquired under that  
deed by C. N. Garland has passed down to A. L. Yelton. The said T. H.
