Know All Men by These Presents:

That I, **W. S. Holman**, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of - - Eighteen Hundred and no/100 (\$1800.00) - - - - DOLLARS. and assumption of mortgage hereinbelow described to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said **William C. Henry, his heirs and assigns:**

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with buildings and improvements thereon lying and being on the Western side of the White Horse Road near the City of Greenville, South Carolina, being shown as Lot No. 11 of part of Tract 2 on the plat of Estate of John B. Marshall, as recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book "J" at pages 132-133 and having, according to said plats, the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Western side of the White Horse Road at a point 975 feet Southwest of the intersection of the White Horse Road and the Old Easley Bridge Road at the joint front corners of Lots Nos. 10 and 11, and running thence along the joint line of said lots N. 80-30 W. 210 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 9-30 W. 80 feet to an iron pin joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 11 and 12; thence along the joint line of Lots Nos. 11 and 12, S. 80-30 E. 210 feet to an iron pin on the Western side of the White Horse Road and running thence along the Western side of the White Horse Road, N. 9-30 E. 80 feet to the point of beginning. This being the same property conveyed to grantor herein by deed of Gerald Tate Crawford by his deed dated 28th day of December, 1950, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Deed Book 426 at page 33.

Grantee agrees to assume and pay a mortgage given by Gerald Tate Crawford to C. Douglas Wilson & Co., on November 4, 1950, said mortgage being recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Mortgage Book 482 at page 197 and being in the principal amount of \$7,800.00

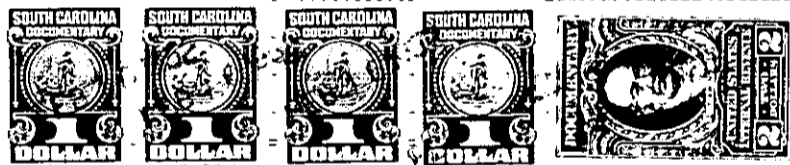
