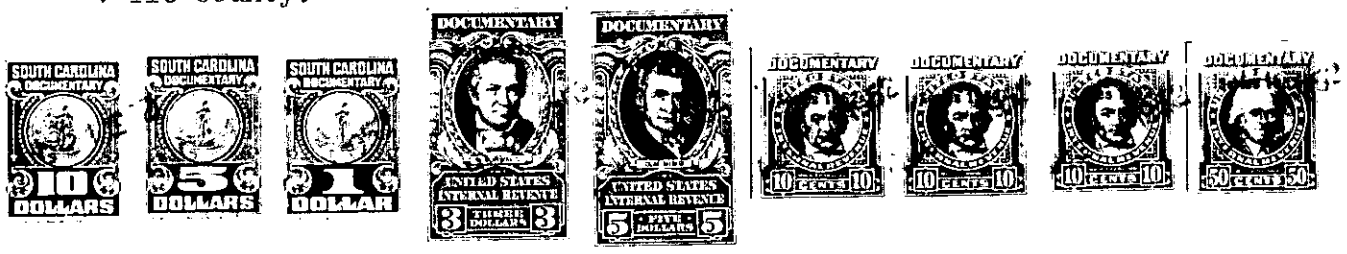
That I, J. ... Cannon in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Seventy-seven Hundred Fifty (\$7750.00) DOLLARS,

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in, Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, state of South Carolina, being known and designated as lot No. 66 on Map # 2 of Sans Souci Heights as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R. L. C. Office for Greenville County in plat book # page 53 and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of Senator Pettus Avenue, the joint corner of lots Nos. 63 & 67, and running thence with the joint line of said lots S. 33-12 E. 95.8 feet to an iron pin corner of lot No. 76; thence with line of said lot N. 59-12 E. 75 feet to an iron pin in the rear line of lot No. 55; thence with the rear line of lots Nos. 55 & 56, N. 35-13 E. 95 feet to an iron pin on the south side of Senator Pettus Avenue; thence with the south side of said Avenue S. 59-05 E. 70 feet to the beginning corner.
