- 3. No residential structure shall be erected or claced on any building plot, which plot has an area of less than 7000 square feet or a width of less than 60 feet at the front building setback line.
- 4. No noxious or offensive rade or activity shall be carried on upon my lot nor shall anything be done thereon which may be or become an annoyance or nuisance to the neighborhood.
- 5. No trailer, see ent, tent, shale, carace, barn, or other outbuilding erected in the tract shall at any time be used as a residence temporarily or permanently, nor shall any structure of a temporary character be used as a residence.
- 6. No duelling shall be permitted on any lot at a cost of less than \$8000.00 hased upon cost levels prevailing on the late of these covenants are recorded, it being the intention and purpose of the covenant to assure that all duellings shall be of a quality of workmanship and materials substantially the same or better than that which can be produced on the date these covenants are recorded at the minimum cost stated herein for the minimum remitted duelling size. The ground floor area of the main structure, exclusive of one-story open norches and garages, shall be not less than 1,000 square feet for a one-story duelling, nor less than 1,000 square feet for a duelling of more than one story.
- 7. This property shall not be recut so as to face any firection other than as shown on the recorded plat thereof.
- 3. All severage disposal shall be by septic tank meeting the approval of the State Board of Health or by Aunicipal Severage System.
