

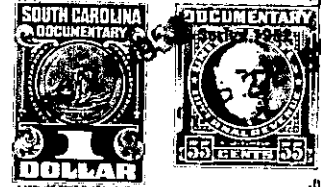

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said D. L. Phillips, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Chick Springs Township, being known and designated as Lot No. 5, of Block C, of a subdivision known as Pinehurst as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book S, at page 77, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the East side of Pinehurst Drive at the corner of Lot No. 4, and running thence along the line of that lot, N. 62-23 E. 144.2 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of said lot; thence S. 25-58 E. 60 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 6; thence along the line of that lot, S. 62-23 W. 143.3 feet to an iron pin at the corner of said lot on the East side of Pinehurst Drive; thence along the East side of Pinehurst Drive, N. 26-48 W. 60 feet to the beginning corner.

The above described lot is a portion of the property conveyed to me by J. B. Hall and R. E. Cox by deed dated November 29, 1948 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 366, at page 451.

The grantee is to pay taxes for the year 1952, said taxes having been pro-rated as of this date.
