That We, Mrs. Brannon Davenport, F. Scott Davenport, Sr., Bonnie D. Medlock, Fredericka D. Reid and J. R. Davenport in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Five Dollars and Partition of real estate DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Francis M. Davenport, Jr., his heirs and assigns forever:

All those tracts of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in Dunklin Township, containing in the aggregate 37.8 acres, and when described as a whole, being more particularly described according to a survey of the property of F.M. Davenport, Sr. Estate, prepared by C.C. Jones, Surveyor, July 1952, recorded in Plat Book BB at Pages 78 and 79, as follows:

BEGINNING at a point in the center of U.S. Highway # 25, at corner of tract this day conveyed to J.R. Davenport, and running thence N. 50-59 E. 263.1 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 41-21 E. 97 feet to iron pin; thence N. 53-49 E. 479.2 feet to a point in the center of a spring; thence N. 63-29 E. 656.3 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 37-00 E. 1010 feet to point in center of a county road; thence S. 37-00 E. 830 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 56-41 W. 632.7 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 42-05 W. 748.9 feet to an iron pin in the center of a County Road; thence N. 42-05 W. 242.3 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 46-12 E. 137.3 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 42-32 W. 497.7 feet; thence S. 41-42 W. 801.6 feet to a point in center of U.S. Highway No. 25; thence with said highway, N. 29-25 W. 682.6 feet to the point of beginning.

This deed is executed in partition of the lands of F.M. Davenport, Sr. at the time of his death, pursuant to the terms of his Last Will and Testament dated December 11, 1945, on file in the office of the Probate Court in Apartment 600, File 6. The grantor, Mrs. Brannon Davenport, joins in the execution of the deed as evidence that she has elected to take under the terms of said Will and to convey any right, title, or interest in the above described land to which she may be entitled.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and his Heirs and Assigns forever.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s) Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
