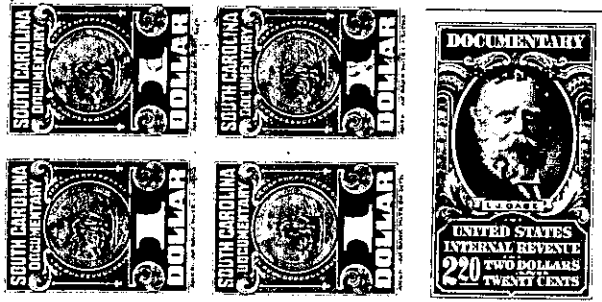

by Henry L Burdette (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Henry L Burdette.....

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Grove Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, having the following meets and bounds ;

BEGINNING at an iron pin, corner of Lots Nos 4 and 6 running thence North 58 West 15.50 to pin; thence South 7 West 10.69 to pin; thence South 24-45- West 5.29 to pin; ^{thence South 65 East 9.28 to pin;} thence North 36-45-East 13.45 to the beginning corner containing 16 acres, more or less, being known as Lot No.5 on a plat of survey made by W.J.Riddle dated July 11th 1924. Also right of way for wagon road through other lands between this land and the Old Georgia Road.
