in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Ten Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty and no/100 (\$10,750.00) DOLLARS,

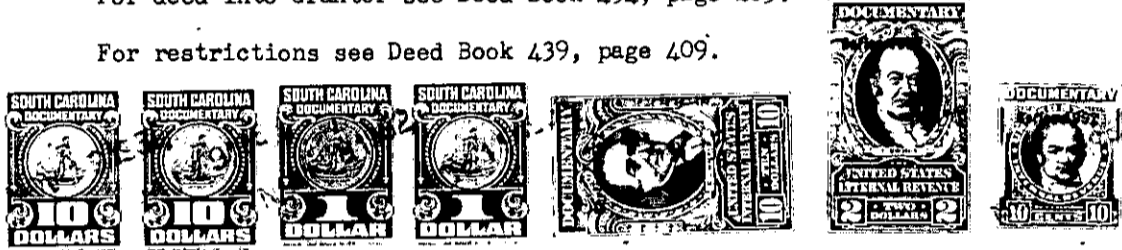
to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Fred L. Jordan, his heirs and assigns, forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, lying and being on the Southeasterly side of Wedgewood Drive, near the City of Greenville, South Carolina, being shown as Lot No. 5 on the plat of North Meadow Heights as recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book "W", page 183, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southeasterly side of Wedgewood Drive, at a point 85 feet North-east of the Southeasterly intersection of Wedgewood Drive and Green Meadow Lane, said pin being the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 4 and 5, and running thence along the Southeasterly side of Wedgewood Drive N 62-14 E 85 feet to an iron pin; thence S 51-43 E 112.5 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of Lots Nos. 1 and 5; thence along the line with Lots Nos. 1 and 2 S 42-18 W 130.2 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of Lots Nos. 4 and 5; thence along the joint line of Lots Nos. 4 and 5 N 30-46 W 147.8 feet to the point of beginning.
