BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northern side of Stone Lake Road in the center of a proposed road intersecting Stone Lake Road, and running thence along the center line of the proposed road (not open) N. 7-40 E. 135 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along the center line of said proposed road N. 13-30 E. 625 feet to an iron pin; thence still with the center line of said proposed road N. 5-39 E. 44.8 feet to an iron pin; thence leaving the said proposed road N. 73-25 E. 825 feet to an iron pin in the line of White Oak Subdivision; thence along the common line of the within described tract and White Oak Subdivision S. 5-05 E. 1130.3 feet to an iron pin on the Northern side of Stone Lake Road; thence along the Northern side of Stone Lake Road N. 80-33 W. 250 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along the Northern side of Stone Lake Road N. 85-33 W. 815 feet to the beginning corner.
