KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that for and in consideration of the mutual covenants, conditions and agreements hereinafter set forth, I, Meade Osborne Bradshaw, of the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, have agreed to grant, bargain and sell unto Harold Williams and the said Harold Williams, hereinafter referred to as Williams, has agreed to purchase all that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina on the northeastern side of South Estate Drive, Gantt Township, and being known and designated as Lot No. 64 on a plat of the property of Crestwood, Inc., plat made by J. C. Hill, February 28, 1949, and which plat is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book S at Page 189.
