limbs or stumps, but shall not be hereby precluded from doing so, if it so desires. The purchaser, agrees to leave all locust laps upon the property herein described.

The purchaser shall have the full term of eighteen (18) months from the date hereof with the right and privilege of extending said term for a period of one year if necessary due to circumstances beyond the control of the purchaser herein, in which to cut and remove the timber hereby conveyed and to use and exercise the rights, privileges and easements hereby granted. Title to so much of said timber and trees as remain on said lands, either standing or fallen, at the expiration of said 18 months, unless extended by the terms of the agreement, shall immediately revert to and become the property of the Seller.

TO THE FAITHFUL PERFORMANCE OF THESE COVENANTS, the parties hereto bind themselves and their heirs, executors, administrators and assigns.
