Anderson have died since his death, namely, Thomas Anderson, October 4, 1945; Emma Lee Anderson, March 1939; and Harold Anderson, October 1938. None of these children of Thomas A. Anderson had any children of their own and the grantors of this deed are the sole remaining devisees and legatees under the aforementioned will of Thomas A. Anderson.
