Kinard Johnson and Albert L. Johnson, their heirs and assigns, forever:

All that lot of land situate on the East side of the Augusta Road, near the City of Greenville, Greenville County, South Carolina, and having according to a survey made by Piedmont Engineering Service, April 1953, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the East side of the Augusta Road at the Southwest corner of a lot this day conveyed by John B. Scoggins to the Grantees herein, and running thence along line of property of the Grantees N. 87-17 E. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along line of property of the Grantees S. 0-01 E. 60 feet to an iron pin; thence along line of other property of the Grantor, E.
