BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS, F. R. CAMP, 15 Cool Springs Drive, Greenville, S. C.,
and
M. R. MILLER, Hillendale Circle, Rt. # 7, Greenville, S. C.

did on the 11th. day of August, 1953, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration, signed by themselves, setting forth:

- FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.
- SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is INVESTORS NINE
- THIRD: That the principal place of business is GREENVILLE, S. C. (15 Cool Springs Drive)

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is to purchase, sell, and/or hold investments of any kind and nature whatsoever, including real estate, personal property and choses in action; and to operate a business or businesses dealing in the merchandising of real estate, personal property and choses in action; and to do any and all things permitted to business corporations by the statutory law of the State of South Carolina

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00) Dollars payable in cash.

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is One Hundred (100) of the par value of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 4th. day of August, 1953, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors: F. R. Camp, M. R. Miller, James D. Shives, William C. McSween, James R. Mann, James B. Bowen, James S. Russell, S. T. Beacham, and Charles B. Robinson, Jr.

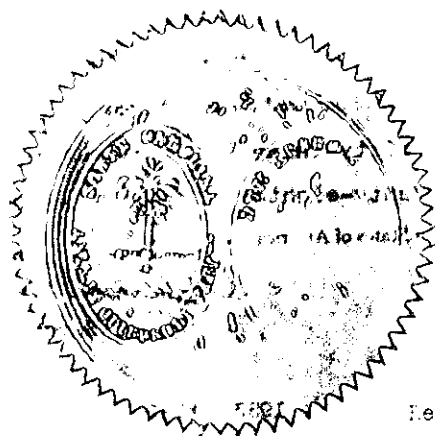
EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, F. R. Camp as Vice-President, William C. McSween as Secretary, S. T. Beacham as Treasurer, M. R. Miller

NINTH: That all requirements of Article 2, Chapter 153, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1952, and all other laws thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 20 percent of the capital stock of said corporation having been paid by the subscribers, 20 percent of the capital stock of said corporation having been paid by the subscribers, and the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been by a notice published in the Greenville Piedmont a newspaper published in the County of Greenville

NOW, THEREFORE, I, O. FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Corporation has been duly organized in the State of South Carolina under its name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that the same shall be a lawful corporation under their charter; and I do hereby attest that a copy of this certificate shall be filed with the Register of Deeds, Clerks of Court in each county where said Corporation shall have a place of business.
