

AFFIDAVIT

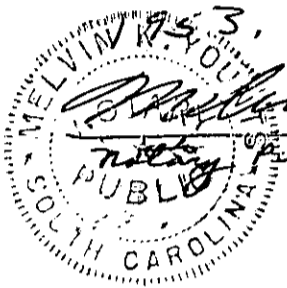
