to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

DORRIS L. DILL AND HELEN S. DILL, their heirs and assigns:

All those pieces, parcels or lots of land situate, lying and being in Chick Springs Township, near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lots Nos. 7 and 8, Property of Clyde Dill, as per plat thereof recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book CC, page 168, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southerly side of Brushy Creek Road, joint front corner Lots 8 and 9 and running thence along the Southerly side of Brushy Creek Road N. 86-38 W. 150 feet to an iron pin in the Southeast intersection of Brushy Creek Road and an un-named street; thence along the Easterly side of the said un-named street S. 0-38 E. 183.7 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 89-22 E. 150 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner Lots 8 and 9; thence N. 0-38 W. 173.3 feet to an iron pin to point of beginning.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and their Heirs and Assigns forever.

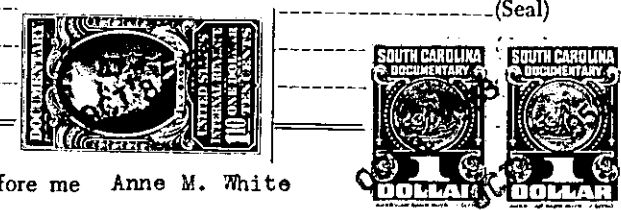
