All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Bates Township, near the town of Travelers Rest, and being known and designated as all of Lot No. 65 and a small portion from the south side of Lot No. 66 of a subdivision of the property of Ray E. McAlister as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County and having, according to a more recent survey made on June 5, 1953, by C. Edgar Williams, Jr., Surveyor, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
