All that lot of land situate on the north side of a county road in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, S. C., and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the north side of said county road, at southeast corner of property of Gaines Batson and running thence along line of Gaines Batson property, N. 5-00 E. 1.80 chains to an iron pin in line of property of the Grantees; running thence along line of property of Grantees Due East 20 feet to an iron pin at corner of lot this day conveyed by the Grantees to the Grantor; thence S. 5-00 W. 1.80 chains, more or less, to an iron pin on the north side of said county road; thence with north side of said road in a westernly direction, 20 feet to the beginning point.

This strip of land is to be used and maintained as a road for the joint use of the Grantees, their heirs and assigns, and the Grantor, his heirs and assigns. The Grantees agree that they will convey this property to Greenville County for a public road at any time the said county will agree to accept a deed to said property and maintain a public road thereon.
