A G R E E M E N T

WHEREAS, the undersigned Rev. John G. Wilson and Ralph Grady Greer are the owners of a 3 inch water line on Hillrose Avenue, and Galphin Drive, and

WHEREAS, they wish to confirm the agreement made with reference to this line and to divide their mutual rights and liabilities.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is mutually agreed as follows:

1. That the said Rev. John G. Wilson shall be entitled to thirteen taps on the water line.
2. That the remaining taps on the line shall be exclusively for the use of the said Ralph Grady Greer.
