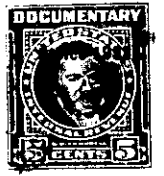

 does grant, bargain, sell and release unto Earle R. Aycock, his heirs and assigns, for-
 ever:

All that lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon,
 situate on the southeast side of Sir Abbot Street, near the City of
 Greenville, in Greenville County, S. C., being shown as Lot No. 109
 on plat of Sherwood Forest, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, August
 1951, revised through November 1952, recorded in the R.M.C. Office
 for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "GG", at Pages 2 and 3,
 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds,
 to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southeast side of Sir Abbot Street,
 at joint front corner of Lots 108 and 109 and running thence with the line
 of Lot 108, S. 27-14 E. 155 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 62-46 W. 75
 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 110, N. 27-14 W.
 155 feet to an iron pin on the southeast side of Sir Abbot Street;
