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KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, JOHN T. DOUGLASS,

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars and other considerations

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said L. A. Moseley, his heirs and assigns, forever:

ALL my undivided one-half interest in and to those lots of land situate on the Northwest side of Sir Abbot Street and on the Southwest side of Friartuck Road, in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, South Carolina, shown as Lots 95, 96, 97, and 60 on plat of Survey, dated November, 1952, revised December, 1952, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "G", at pages 2 and 3, and containing, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

LOTS 95, 96 and 97 BEING DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

Beginning at an iron pin on the Northwest corner of Lots 95 and 96 running North 87 degrees 45 minutes East 187.3 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 87-45 E., 320 feet to an iron pin; thence along the rear line of Lots 95 and 101, S. 1-30 E., 286.4 feet to an iron pin on the Southwest corner of Sir Abbot Street; thence along the curve of the rear line of Lots 95 and 101, S. 87-45 E., 69.6 feet to an iron pin; thence along the curve of Sir Abbot Street (the original bearing S. 87-45 E., 75 feet) to an iron pin; thence still with the curve of Sir Abbot Street (bearing S. 67-5 E., 75 feet) to the beginning corner.

LOT 60 BEING DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

Beginning at an iron pin on the Southeast corner of Lots 60 and 61 running South 41 degrees 56 minutes West 111.7 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 41-56 W., 111.1 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 41-56 E., 111.1 feet to an iron pin on the Southwest side of Friartuck Road; thence along the rear line of Friartuck Road, S. 41-56 E., 106 feet to the beginning corner.

A quantity acre or less is included in the above description, being land of the first national bank of Greenville, S. C., situated under the hill of S. Spratt Warren, alias, "The Hill", 1951, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book 430 at page 368.
