All that certain piece, parcel or lots of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lots No. 85 and 86 on Bridges Avenue according to plat of Pine Brook Development, made by W. N. Willis, Engineer, March 27, 1951, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "Z", at Page 149, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northern side of Bridges Avenue at the joint corner of Lots 46 and 85, thence along rear lines of Lots 46 and 45, N. 16-54 W 150 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 73-06 E. 140 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots 86 and 87; thence along common line of Lots 86 and 87, S. 16-54 E. 150 feet to an iron pin on Northern side of Bridges Avenue; thence along Bridges Avenue, S. 73-06 W. 140 feet to an iron pin, point of beginning.

This conveyance is made subject to the Restrictive and Protective Covenants applicable to Pine Brook and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Book of Deeds 443, at Page 307, and in Book of Deeds 462, at Page 33.
