A. Waldrop, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina on the west side of Bates Drive being Lot No. 17 on a Plat of Northside Gardens as shown on plat recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book S, page 17, and being more particularly described as follows, to-wit:
