SEPARATION AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the undersigned, J. Willard Clark and Beatrice P. WHEREAS, the said parties, on account of unhappy differences arising, and which differences are wholly inreconcilable, have after due consideration, come to the conclusion that it is unwise to continue their marital relations, and have agreed to live separate and a part from each other as man and wife, neither of the parties, however, charge the other with any conduct reflecting upon the morals of either; and

WHEREAS, the parties, after due consideration, have reached a full and completesatisfactory adjustment of property rights, and future acquirements of property by either, now, therefore,

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that inconsideration of the stipulations hereinafter contained and the premises above, the said Beatrice P. Clark does:

- (1) Hereby release and discharge said J. Willard Clark from any and all claims for future support, maintenance, attendance, protection and any and all other duties arising from said marital contract.
- (2) The said J. Willard Clark does hereby waive all claims against the said Beatrice P. Clark in the way of personal attention, marital duties as a wife, devotion and care
