



Gantt. all that piece, parcel or lot of land in

Greenville Township,

County State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 16 of Pecan Terrace, according to a Plat thereof prepared by Piedmont Engineering Service, dated March 27, 1953 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book GG, Page 9 and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-vit:

BEGINHING at an iron pin on the Eastern side of Mayflower Avenue Joint front corner of Lots Nos. 15 and 16 and running thence along the joint line of said lots S. 72-27 E. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 17-33 W. 70 feet to an iron pin joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 16 and 17; thence along the joint line of said lots N. 80-48 W. 137.2 feet to an iron pin on the Eastern side of Mayflower Avenue; thence along the curvature of said Avenue, North 47 feet to an iron pin on the Eastern side of said Avenue; thence along said Avenue N. 17-33 E. 45.0 feet to the point of beginning.
