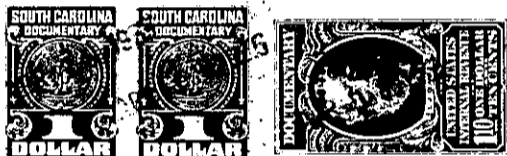
That I, B. P. Crenshaw

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, State aforesaid and being known and designated as Lot No. 5 of a subdivision known as Ila Court, according to survey made by C. C. Jones, Engineer, plat being recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in deed book BB at page 101, and according to said plat being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on a street designated as Ila Court, joint corner of lots 4 and 5 and running along the line of Lot No. 4, S. 28-55 E. 135 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of lots 4 and 5; thence N. 61-05 E. 80 feet to the joint rear corner of lots 5 and 6; thence along the line of Lot No. 6, N. 28-55 W. 135 feet to an iron pin on Ila Court; thence along Ila Court, S. 61-05 W. 80 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner.
