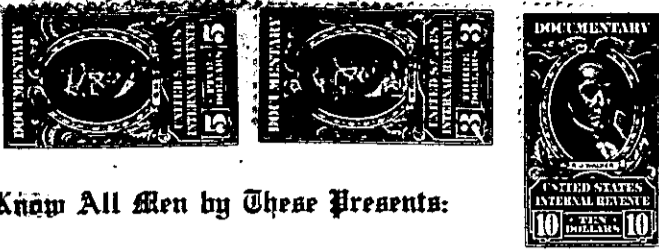

More, Inc., a Delaware corporation, its successors and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land lying and being on the Westerly side of New Grove Road, which is U. S. Highway No. 29, near the City of Greenville, S. C., and having according to a recent survey made by Dalton & Neves, dated March 1954, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Westerly edge of the 100 foot right-of-way of U. S. Highway No. 29 (new Grove Road), said pin being the joint corner of the property of the grantor and L. J. Finley, and running thence along the common line of the Garrison and Finley property N 80-54 W 450 feet to an iron pin; thence N 24-41 E 965.5 feet to an iron pin, corner of property of the grantor and property now or formerly belonging to E. E. Chapman; thence along the line with the Chapman property N 81-02 W 432 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along the line of the Chapman property N 77-56 W 382 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along the line of the Chapman property S 14-18 W 237 feet to an iron pin, corner of property of the grantor and Chapman with property of the WFBC Radio Station; thence along the line of the property of said Radio Station S 14-46 W 901 feet to a railroad rail at the end of a 36 foot road; thence across the end of said road and along the line with the Meaders property S 16-07 E 199 feet to an iron pin; thence N 89-09 E 987.2 feet to an iron pin on the Westerly side of the 100 foot right-of-way of U. S. Highway No. 29 (New Grove Road); thence along the Westerly side of said right-of-way N 25-12 E 200.3 feet to the point of beginning.

Excluded from the above described property are the following lots, as shown on the plat of Biltmore as recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book "Y", page 147: Lots 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 26, 2, 3, 4, 5, 23, 24 and 25, all of which lots the grantor herein retains title thereto, and also excluded from this conveyance is Lot No. 37 which has been previously conveyed to Soula W. Finley.

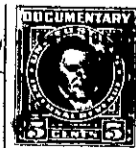
