Leonard Thackston, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, lying and being on the Easterly side of Bent Twig Drive, near the City of Greenville, S. C., being shown as Lot No. 22 on the plat of Biltmore as recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book "Y", page 147, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a concrete marker on the Easterly side of Bent Twig Drive at a point 275 feet South of the Southeasterly corner of the intersection of Bent Twig Drive and Three Notch Road, said pin being the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 22 and 23, and running thence along the joint line of said Lots S 75-14 E 150 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of said lots; thence along the joint line of Lots Nos. 22 and 31 S 14-46 W 75 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 21 and 22; thence along the joint line of said Lots N 75-14 W 150 feet to an iron pin on the Easterly side of Bent Twig Drive; thence along the Easterly side of said Drive N 14-46 E 75 feet to the point of beginning.
