That certain lot or parcel of land, with the improvements thereon, in O'Neal Township, said County and State, on the north side of Berry's Mill road, near O'Neal, and designated as Lots Nos. 1 and 2 on plat of the J. A. Bennet's property, prepared by J. Q. Bruce, Surveyor, May 8, 1941, and delineated as follows:

BEGINNING in the center of said road at junction with a ten-foot st. and runs thence with said street, N. 52-40 W. 237 feet to corner Lot No. 11 thence with line of #11 lot, N. 53-00 E. 135 feet to joint corner nos. 11-10-32 lots; thence subdividing nos. 2 and 3 lots, S. 82-00 E. 230 feet to center of Berry's Mill road; thence thence with S. 83-00 W. 100 feet to corner Lot #1; thence same course, 41.5 feet to iron pin to angle; thence still with said said, S. 60-30 W. 55 feet to the beginning corner, and being same conveyed to said E.
