Know All Men by These Presents:

That I, G. Dewey Oxner, in consideration of the sum of ---Five Hundred Seventy-five (\$575.00)--- in the State aforesaid, DOLLARS, to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Ernestine Collier, her heirs and assigns:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in the City of Greenville, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lot Ten (10) on plat of Carver Park made by Piedmont Engineering Service, October, 1951, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "AA", page 187, and having according to said plat the following courses and distances, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Tuskegee Avenue, joint front corner of Lots 10 and 11 and running thence along the line of Lot 11 S. 43-0 W. 120 feet to an iron pin corner of Lot 6; thence along the line of Lot 6 S. 47-0 E. 40 feet to an iron pin corner of Lot 8; thence along the line of Lot 8 N. 82-05 E. 39.2 feet to an iron pin corner of Lot 9; thence along the line of Lot 9 W. 43-0 E. 90 feet to an iron pin on Tuskegee Avenue; thence along Tuskegee Avenue N. 47-0 W. 65 feet to the beginning corner.

The lot above described is conveyed subject to the covenants and restrictions recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 444, page 498, which are made a part hereof as fully as if set out herein, and to the public utility easement granted to the Duke Power Company, which is recorded in said R.M.C. Office in Deed Book 445, page 235. It is understood and agreed that Lot No. 21 (Twenty-one) of Carver Park, or any part thereof, may be used for street purposes, so as to permit Weston Street, now Elder Street, to be extended across Lot No. 21.

The lot herein conveyed constitutes a portion of the property conveyed to me by R. M. Caine, by deed dated March 10, 1951, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 430, page 372.

Taxes for the current year are to be paid by the grantor. TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and her Heirs and Assigns forever.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s) Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
