

mutual consent and permission of the other, and that neither of said parties shall acquire any rights over the property of the other nor shall any such permissive use constitute a basis for adverse possession.

2. It is further mutually agreed that the gates which are a part of the fences located where the fences cross the old right-of-way of Southern Railway Company shall be kept locked and that each of the parties hereto shall have a right to a key to said locks so as to give each of the parties hereto a means of ingress and egress to and from their respective properties.
