assigns, an undivided one-half (1/2) interest in and to all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the east side of North Main Street in the block between East Washington and East Coffee Streets, and having according to survey thereof made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, May, 1940, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
