EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS, EUGENE BRYANT and W. FRANCIS MARION, 6 4 24 PM 1956
both of
Greenville, South Carolina OLLIE FARNOWORTH

did on the 5th day of July, 19 56, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration, signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is VEND CO.

THIRD: That the principal place of business is Greenville, South Carolina

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is to buy and sell, hold, distribute and service automatic vending machines of all kinds, including the taking of all steps necessary or desirable to promote such purchases and sales, holdings, distributions and servicings, and the doing of all things incidental thereto.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is One Thousand (\$1,000.00) ----- Dollars payable in cash

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is One Hundred (100) of the par value of Ten (\$10.00) ----- Dollars.

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 2nd day of July, 19 56, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors: Eugene Bryant, C. F. Haynsworth, Jr., R. E. Houston, Jr., W. Francis Marion and Christie C. Prevost

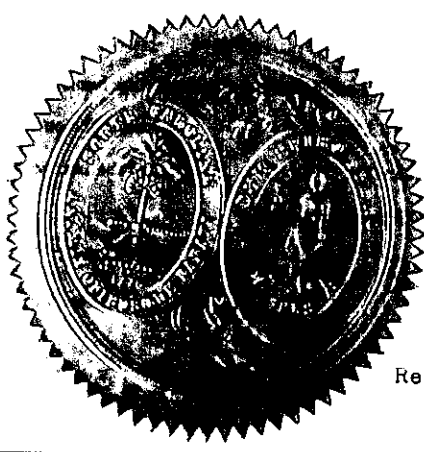
EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, Eugene Bryant ; and R. E. Houston, Jr. ; as Vice-President, C. F. Haynsworth, Jr. / ; as Secretary, W. Francis Marion ; as Treasurer, Christie C. Prevost

NINTH: That all requirements of Title 12, Article 1, Chapter 2, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1952, and all amendments thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in The Greenville Piedmont a newspaper published in the County of Greenville

NOW, THEREFORE, I, O. FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.

GIVEN under my hand and the seal of the State, at Columbia, this 5th day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-six and in the one hundred and eighty-first year of the Independence of the United States of America.
