That, the said organization holds, or desires to hold, property in common for Religious, Educational, Social, Fraternal, Charitable or other eleemosynary purpose, or any two or more of said purposes, and is not organized for the purpose of profit or gain to the members, otherwise than is above stated, nor for the insurance of life, health, accident or property; and that three days' notice in the The Greenville Piedmont, a newspaper published in the County of Greenville, has been given that the aforesaid Declaration would be filed.

AND WHEREAS, Said Declarants and Petitioners further declared and affirmed:

FIRST: Their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: The name of the proposed Corporation is

LICENSED PRACTICAL NURSES ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE COUNTY, INC.

THIRD: The place at which it proposes to have its headquarters or be located is GREENVILLE, S. C.

FOURTH: The purpose of the said proposed Corporation is for the advancement and regulation of the educational standard of nursing, the furtherance of the efficient care of the sick, the maintenance of the honor, high standards of integrity, and character among the Licensed Practical nurses. To protect the interest of its members and cooperate with other organizations.
