WHEREAS, Faye Ellis Wood is desirous of committing the care, maintenance, education and support of Harry Dale Wood to John & Mary Deal, and whereas, the said John & Mary Deal agrees to accept the care, custody, maintenance, education and support of the said Harry Dale Wood during his minority and further agrees that they will by proper desire and bequest make him equal with their own children in the distribution of their estate, and that they will further hold and manage all the property of the said Harry Dale Wood and the increase thereof for Harry Dale Wood separate use until he shall have married or arrived at the age of twenty-one years.

NOW, THEREFORE, Know all men by these presents, that Faye Ellis Wood for and in consideration of the premises herein stated, have agreed to and do hereby commit the care, custody, maintenance, education and support of Harry Dale Wood infant child, born on the 15th day of June, 1956 A.D., to for and during his minority. TOGETHER, with the rights, privileges and benefits that could be exercised by John and Mary Deal as parents over and in respect to the said Harry Dale Wood, To have and to hold, the said Harry Dale Wood against me and any and all persons claiming or to claim any interest, right or privilege through parentship or otherwise, in and to the said Harry Dale Wood (rather unknown).
