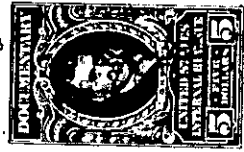

Know All Men by these Presents:

That I, Blanche W. Putman in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of FIVE THOUSAND AND NO/100 DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said C. H. Elalock and Nelle R. Elalock, their heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying on the Southern side of Converse Street, formerly Circle Street, within the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, being shown as lot # 22, on plat of Hillside Heights, subdivision of Tract # 3 of Overbrook Property, prepared by R. E. Dalton, September 1921, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book F at Page 100, and described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southern side of Converse Street, at the front corner of lot # 23, and running thence with the line of said lot, S. 5-51 E. 150 feet to an iron pin on the line of property now or formerly of Williams; thence with said Williams line, N. 72-41 E. 110 feet to an iron pin, rear corner of lot # 21; thence with the line of said lot, N. 25-03 W. 150 feet to an iron pin on the South side of Converse Street; thence with the curve of south side of said street, the traverse of which is S. 70-55 W. 60 feet to the point of beginning.

Being the same lot conveyed to the grantor by T. A. Putman by deed recorded in Book of Deeds 490 at Page 43.

Grantees are to pay 1956 taxes.

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and their Heirs and Assigns forever.
