have filed a complete report of all receipts and disbursements made by the said Robert J. Edwards as Trustee. It appears from the testimony that the accounting is not questioned by any of the parties to this proceeding, nor is there any objection filed to the appointment of William M. Edwards as Trustee. The testimony shows that I hold that the said William M. Edwards is a competent person to serve in said capacity.

The terms of the deed creating the trust is as follows:

sequently duly appointed as administratrices of the estate and as such

"TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said premises above mentioned unto the said Martha Jane Edwards for and during the term of her natural life, from and immediately after her death unto the said B. Ferry Edwards and Robert J. Edwards, the survivor of them, in trust, nevertheless, to plant or to rent said premises and to receive the rents, issues and profits thereof for the maintenance and su nort of the said James M. Edwards as long as he shall live, and to divide the same amongst his neirs freed from all trusts with power to sell for distributing, if necessary, after his death."
