ASSIGNMENT OF BONDS FOR TITLE

WHEREAS on the 22nd day of July, 1942, Mountain Lake Colonies, Inc. did execute and deliver its certain bond for title to Mrs. R. H. Stewart covering a certain lot of land in Greenville County, South Carolina known as Lot No. 17 on a map of the property of Mountain Lake Colonies prepared by W. D. Neves, C.E., said map being recorded in the Office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Plat Book D at page 236 and 237 and,

WHEREAS said bond for title was assigned to Martha Stewart Scott, the daughter of the said Mrs. R. H. Stewart on the 20th day of January, 1945 and such bond for title and assignment was filed for record in the Office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Deed Book 271 at page 511 and,

WHEREAS on the 14th day of May, 1947, Mountain Lake Colonies, Inc. did execute and deliver to Martha Stewart Scott its bond for title for a lot of land in Greenville County, South Carolina known as Lot No. 16 of the Mountain Lake Colonies property according to map prepared by W. D. Neves, C. E., said map being recorded in the Office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Plat Book D, pages 236 and 237 but said bond for title has never been recorded and,

WHEREAS Martha Stewart Scott has agreed to sell her interest in Lot No. 17 and the eastern one-half of Lot No. 16 to James E. Waldrep and,

WHEREAS Martha Stewart Scott has agreed to sell her interest in the western one-half of Lot No. 16 to Sidney M. Wilson,
