leaving his or her property to go to his or her respective child or children by descent and distribution.

- 2. Since each of the parties hereto have been previously married, it is mutually agreed:
 - (a) That the said C. N. Wallace, Sr., shall be buried by the side of his first wife's grave Martha Lela Thomas Wallace, in Graceland Cemetery, in or near the City of Greenville, South Carolina; and,
 - (b) That the said Margaret B. Wallace shall be buried by the side of her first husband's grave Edmund J. Bald, in Uniondale Cemetery, in Northside, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania.

The respective estates of the parties hereto shall bear the expenses of their respective burials.

of the parties hereto - that now owned and/or hereafter acquired, wherever situate, but shall not be a relinquishment of, or in any way impair, the right of the said Margaret B. Wallace to claim and receive social security and/or other like benefits, during the lifetime of the said C. N. Wallace, Sr., or after his death, to which she is, or may be, entitled by reason of their said markful relationship or otherwise.
