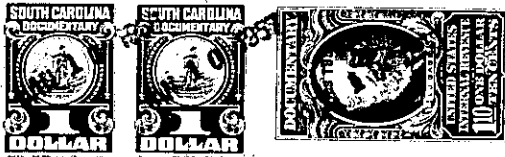
Know All Men by These Presents:

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said grantee(s) Albert L. Smith and his heirs and assigns forever:

All of those certain parcels of lots of land situated on the southeast side of the old Greenville-Spartanburg Road, about two (2) miles from the City of Greer, and near Pleasant Grove Baptist Church, in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and being Lots Nos. 28 and 30 of the J.M. Mattox Estate according to survey and plat by H.S. Brockman, Registered Surveyor, dated November 6, 1952, amended February 25, 1956, and recorded in Plat Book JJ, page 127, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stake on the southeast side of said old Greenville-Spartanburg Road, corner of Lots Nos. 26 and 28, and running thence along the line of said lots, S. 41.20 E. 200 feet to a stake, rear corner of Lot No. 29; thence along the rear line of Lots Nos. 29 and 31, S. 48.40 W. 200 feet to a stake on edge of an unnamed street; thence along said street, N. 41.20 W. 200 feet to the old Greenville-Spartanburg Road; thence along said road, N. 48.40 E. 200 feet to the beginning corner.
