WHEREAS by written instrument of <sup>OLLIE FARNSWORTH</sup> February 26, 1953 and of record in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book Volume 475 at page 121, the undersigned Realty National Company, a corporation of the State of South Carolina with its principal place of business in Greenville, South Carolina, gave its consent to the closing, by the Peoples National Bank of Greenville, South Carolina, of a certain ten (10) foot alley extending from the west side of North Laurens Street in the City of Greenville, South Carolina in a western direction a distance of 62 feet and likewise by said instrument consented to said bank constructing a building across said alley to the height of one story and,

WHEREAS the said Peoples National Bank of Greenville, South Carolina is now desirous of adding another story (second story) to a portion of the building constructed over and across said alley, to-wit, the portion extending from Laurens Street in a westerly direction a distance of 42 feet and being the portion of said building abutting and immediately adjacent to the northern side of the building of said Peoples National Bank of Greenville, South Carolina.
