


Fairview all that piece, parcel or lot of land in

County, State of South Carolina consisting of the three (3) following tracts of land and containing in the aggregate 147.51 acres, more or less:

1. All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, being bounded by lands now or formerly of J. A. Wham, Richard Abercrombie, et al and containing according to a plat made by J. A. Adams, Surveyor, November
