Know All Men by These Presents:

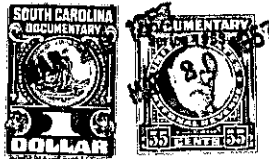
That We, Joseph H. Brannon and Pauline Brannon, in the State aforesaid,

W. Dennis Smith and his heirs and assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land near the City of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 69 of a subdivision known as Bellwood Estates, as shown by a plat thereof, dated May, 1950, and made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
