

ALL that parcel or tract of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situate on the North side of a county road in O'Neal Township, Greenville County, S. C., on waters of Beaverdam Creek and South Tyger River, and is known as a portion of the B. F. Few home place, and being the land formerly owned by the late Merida Waldrop, and having according to a plat made by J. Mac Richardson, Surveyor, March 1957, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at a stone in the county road at corner of lands now or formerly of L. G. Prince, Committee for J. E. Bagwell, and running thence along the said county road N. 70-30 E. 1283.7 feet to a point in the said county road; thence N. 26-00 E. 1122 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 17-30 E. 100.3 feet to a stone; thence N. 31 E. 175.6 feet to a point in center of creek; thence up the creek as a line in a Westerly direction to a point at the corner of lands now or formerly of Blackwell; thence along said Blackwell line S. 50-00 W. 772.2 feet to a stake; thence along line of property now or formerly of Stargel S. 6-00 E. 957 feet to stone; thence N. 70-30 E. 326.7 feet to a stone; thence S. 19-30 E. 231 feet to a stone in said county road, the beginning corner, and contains 50 acres, more or less.
