in consideration of the sum of Three Thousand One Hundred Eighteen and 06/100--- and the assumption of the mortgage as hereinafter set forth to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Gertha Moyd, her heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina on the western side of Biltmore Avenue being known and designated as Lot No. 7 of the property of Roy J. Meaders and having according to a plat prepared by Piedmont Engineering Service dated July 24, 1954 the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the western side of Biltmore Avenue at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 8 and 7 and running thence N. 80-25 W. 234.3 feet to a point; thence N. 10-53 E. 66.1 feet to a point; thence S. 80-09 E. 232.7 feet to a point on Biltmore Avenue; thence with Biltmore Avenue S. 9-26 W. 65 feet to the point of beginning.

This being one of the lots conveyed to the Grantor herein by deed of Mrs. Willie Martin dated September 21, 1954 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 508, at Page 490.

As a part of the consideration herein the Grantee expressly assumes a mortgage given to First Federal Savings and Loan Association in the original amount of \$9,000 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Mortgage Book 610 at Page 385, having a present balance of \$8,231.94.

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and her Heirs and Assigns forever.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s) Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
